

BRR JUNIOR CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE RULES & INFO

MEDALS WILL BE AWARDED TO ALL MEMBERS WHO COMPETE IN AT LEAST THREE RACES IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE, AT OUR CROSS COUNTRY MEDAL PRESENTATION IN MARCH, FOR THE COMMITMENT THEY HAVE SHOWN.

GOLD SILVER AND BRONZE MEDALS WILL BE AWARDED FOR FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD PLACE IN EACH AGE GROUP SHOWN.

THE SHONA CROMBIE-HICKS TROPHIE'S WILL BE PRESENTED TO THE MALE AND FEMALE MEMBER WITH THE LOWEST FINAL SCORE WHICH THEY KEEP FOR THE YEAR.

WE INCLUDE AN U9 AGE GROUP IN THE CLUB CROSS COUNTRY COMPETITION. THERE IS NOT AN U9 AGE GROUP IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE. THE YOUNGEST AGE GROUP IS U11.

FINAL POSITIONS ARE DETERMINED BY CALCULATING EACH MEMBERS BEST THREE FINISHING POSITIONS

YOU CANNOT INCLUDE YOUR FINISHING POSITION IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY COUNTY CHAMPIONSHIPS UNLESS YOU HAVE COMPETED IN AT LEAST THREE RACES IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE.

IF A MEMBER HAS TAKEN PART IN AT LEAST ONE RACE BUT HAVE MISSED ANY RACES THAT HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE, THEY WILL BE GIVEN A SCORE OF "1000"

ANY MEMBER WITH A SCORE OF OVER 2000 WOULD NOT HAVE COMPLETED THREE RACES IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE AND THEREFORE WILL NOT BE AWARDED A MEDAL AT OUR CROSS COUNTRY MEDAL PRESENTATION. **THEIR FINAL POSITION WILL STILL BE SHOWN IN RED.**

THE MORE RACES A MEMBER TAKES PART IN THE GREATER THE CHANCE THEY HAVE OF MOVING UP THE TABLE AS THE NUMBERS IN EACH RACE CAN VARY GREATLY. ANY MEMBER WHO TAKES PART IN A RACE WITH LOWER NUMBERS GAIN AN ADVANTAGE DUE TO THEIR LOWER FINISHING POSITION. THIS OFTEN HAPPENS IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS.

IF ANY JUNIOR STARTS A RACE BUT CANNOT FINISH. THE LEADERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO AWARD A POSITION. (POSITION IN GREEN)
THE POSITION GIVEN WILL BE LAST POSITION IN THE RACE.
THIS WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED ONCE IN THIS COMPETITION AT THE LEADERS DISCRETION.
