Code of Conduct for Athletes

Listen and respond to the guidance of your team leader, helper, volunteer

Treat others with the same respect and fairness that you wish to receive

Uphold the same values off the road/field as you do when engaged in athletics

Anticipate your own needs; be organized, on time and properly clothed

Thank those who help you participate in athletics

Inform your team leader, helper, volunteer of any other coaching you receive

Show patience and respect diversity in others

Notify a responsible adult if you have to go somewhere

Strictly maintain a clear boundary between friendship and intimacy with a team leader, helper, official or other person with whom you train

Never accept a lift in cars or invitations into homes on your own or without the prior knowledge and consent of your parent/guardian

Use safe transport or travel arrangements

Avoid destructive behavior and leave athletics venues as you find them

Never engage in any illegal or irresponsible behavior

Persistent breaches of this code of conduct will result in your membership being terminated

Speak out immediately if anything makes you concerned or uncomfortable (telling a club official) or if you suspect a club mate has suffered from misconduct by someone else
