MEDALS WILL BE AWARDED TO ALL MEMBERS WHO COMPETE IN AT LEAST THREE RACES IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE.

GOLD SILVER AND BRONZE MEDALS WILL BE AWARDED FOR FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD PLACE IN EACH AGE GROUP SHOWN.

THERE WILL BE A RUNNERS UP MEDAL FOR ANY JUNIOR OUTSIDE THE TOP THREE PLACES AS LONG AS THEY HAVE RAN IN AT LEAST THREE RACES

WE INCLUDE AN U9 AGE GROUP IN THE CLUB CROSS COUNTRY COMPETITION. THERE IS NOT AN U9 AGE GROUP IN THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE. THE YOUNGEST AGE GROUP IS U11.

FINAL POSITIONS ARE DETERMINED BY CALCULATING EACH MEMBERS THREE LOWEST FINISHING POSITIONS

IF ANY JUNIOR STARTS A RACE BUT CANNOT FINISH DUE TO INJURY OR ILLNESS, THE LEADERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO AWARD THE MEMBER, LAST POSITION IN THE RACE, SO THEY DO NOT MISS OUT ON A MEDAL. THIS WILL BE ALLOWED TWICE DURING THE DURATION OF THIS COMPETITION.

IN THE EVENT OF A CROSS COUNTRY COMPETITION TAKING PLACE ON THE SAME DAY AS THE CROSS COUNTRY LEAGUE EVENT, THE LEADERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO GIVE THE MEMBER THE LAST POSITION PLUS 1, SO THEY DO NOT MISS OUT ON A MEDAL OR 3, 5, 7 YEAR AWARDS. PROOF THEY TOOK PART MUST BE GIVEN. THIS WILL ONLY BE CONSIDERED FOR SCHOOL COMPETITIONS WHEN QUALIFYING FOR A COUNTY PLACE OR COMPETING FOR THE COUNTY. NO OTHER RACES WILL BE CONSIDERED. THIS IS LIMITED TO ONE EVENT ONLY FOR THE XC COMPETITION AND TWO FOR THE 3.5 OR 7 YEAR AWARDS. POINTS WILL ALSO BE GIVEN FOR THE RACE CHAMP AWARD.
